Voting by points.

1) Rules and topic



1. This competition is open to all members of Naturefriends. The membership number is required for participation. Checks will be carried out, in case of a missing membership, the participant will be disqualified.
2. This is an individual competition.
3. The participants guarantee that they are the sole owners of the rights and elements of their images and authorise the organisers to use their images free of charge to promote this competition via the media of Naturefriends France. They also allow the Federation to use these images in its publications on all media for a period of 5 years.
4. The theme is: Water

2) Conditions of participation

1. This contest is free of charge. You must have an email address and be a member of Naturefriends.
2. The files will be sent only by internet on the site: pollunit.com/polls/anf125ans
3. Each author will participate with a maximum of 2 images in colour and/or black & white.
4. After registration, you just have to upload your files on the dedicated website.
5. These files must be in a minimum format of 12 Mpx (4242x2828 px) and a maximum size of 50 Mb (in case of lower resolution, the loading of the photos will not be possible).
6. Titles will have a maximum of 25 characters
7. The competition is limited to 500 images.

3) Vote (via internet)

1. Depending on the number of images received, a pre-selection can be made.
2. The scores will be made by Internet users directly on the competition website.
3. Voting is allowed only once per person. A system of email address control and IP address verification will be set up to avoid multiple entries.
4. Voting will take place in parallel with the submission of photos by the authors to allow a large number of people to participate and the public to vote.

4) Jury final

1. The final jury will be composed of the national president Christine Schmitt, Jean-Michel Harp (president of the local association of Fécamp) and an outside photographer: Johann Touanen.
2. The images will be projected in a predetermined order.



5) Awards and others

1. The 10 best images will be rewarded as follows:

- The 3 best pictures : a 20*30 cm wood print, a 2-night stay for 4 people in a Naturefriends accommodation, as well as a Naturefriends centenary book.
- The 7 following images: a 20*30 cm wood print, a 2-night stay for 2 people in a Naturefriends accommodation as well as a copy of the Naturefriends centenary book.

The winning photos will make up a traveling exhibition that will travel between Naturefriends France's facilities and will be exhibited at the Evian Congress in May 2021. It may also be exhibited at the Federation's headquarters. The first 3 images will be printed in 50x60cm American case and the next 7 in 20x30cm framed.

A photo book will be made from the 50 best images and will be sold at cost price.
